

RACING TERM	MEANING
Total Races Started	The amount of times the driver started the race (but did not necessarily finish) over their entire career.
DNF	The amount of times the driver started the race but DID NOT finish the race over their entire career.
Wins	The amount of times a driver finished a race 1 st over their career.
2 nd Place Finishes	The amount of times a driver finished a race in second place for their entire career.
Top 10 Finishes	The amount of times a driver finished a race in the top ten out of all drivers in the race.
Poles	The pole position is the position at the inside of the front row at the start of a racing event. This position is typically given to the vehicle and driver with the best qualifying time in the trials before the race.
Total Laps	The total amount of laps a driver completed over the driver's entire career.
Total Laps Led	The total times the driver was in first place after a complete lap over their career.
Winning %	The percentage of wins out of all the races started over the driver's career. (The win% in the table is expressed as a decimal not a percent. Therefore, it needs to be converted to a percent.)
Total Points	The total amount of points the driver earned during their entire career.
Championships	The amount of time the driver finished with the most points at the end of a racing season (year).
